

NCIDEA

- Mission: Economic development in North Carolina
- Charter: Provide funding for developing high-growth companies
- Structure: Independent not-for profit (not State funded)



Company Formation





Grants Program Description

- Up to \$50,000 awards
- Available to NC companies pursuing a high-growth path.
- Funds for business-related expenses only, not for research activities.
- Funds must not be used for founder's salaries.
- Preference given to companies without previous VC funding.
- Areas of focus:
- Information technology
- Medical devices
- New materials
- MBA entrepreneurs available to help move companies forward.


Program Goals

- Increase NCIDEA deal flow for equity investments.




Process Flow

- 3 month cycle
- 2 phase application
- Online submittal
- Evaluations and decisions made by NCIDEA staff
- Advisory board provides evaluation and selection guidance
